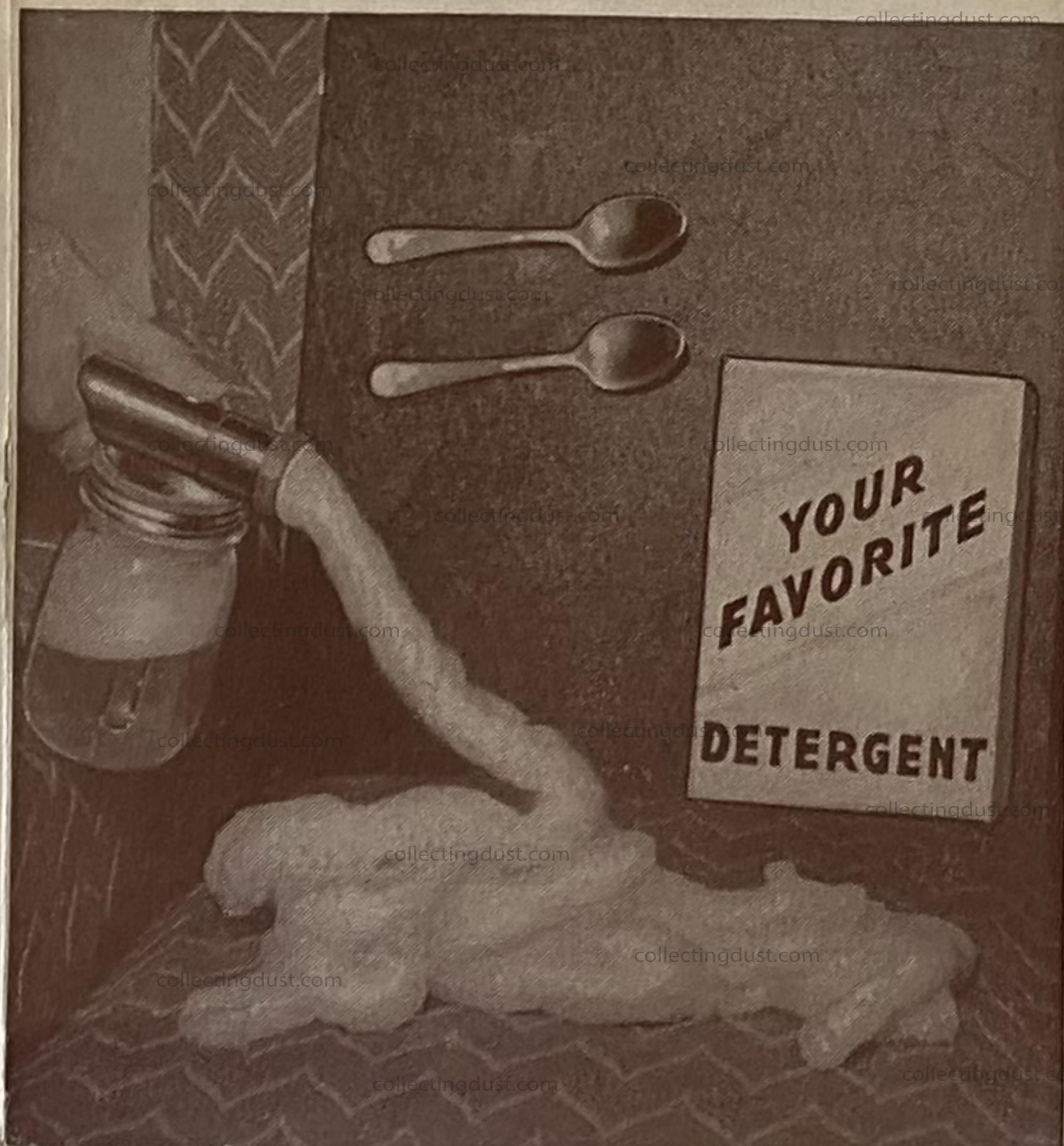


# HOW TO OPERATE THE SUDS-O-GUN



## CONNECTION

Connect the Spray Gun to the Cleaner in the regular way, with the blower connection and the flexible hose attached to the power plant. Attach the Spray Gun to the hose and then attach the Suds-O-Gun metal part firmly on to the rounded nose end of the Sprayer. The notch in the Suds-O-Gun metal part goes underneath



so that it clears the place where the Spray Gun tube is attached to the jar cover. Make sure that the cloth screen completely covers the smaller end of the Suds-O-Gun metal tube and that it is securely held in place by the rubber band.

## PREPARING THE SOLUTION

Many types of detergent and soap solutions may be used. About two tablespoonsfull of Dreet, Vel or Tide in the proportion to a half-pint of water makes excellent suds. If soap flakes are used, they must be thoroughly dissolved otherwise they may clog the small tube or the screen. In operation, the spray jet

of suds solution strikes the cloth screen, and is broken up into bubbles by the air blast. You will note that the button on top of the Spray Gun is adjustable, turning it governs the amount of spray. A fine spray makes dry suds.

## MAKING THE SUDS

The suds can be piled directly on the surface to be cleaned, or gathered in a wash basin. Because it contains a minimum of water it does not soak up the article to be cleaned. Water can be very harmful if it soaks into the fabric, because it can cause mildew and streaking. The Kirby Suds-O-Gun produces large quantities of extra dry foam.

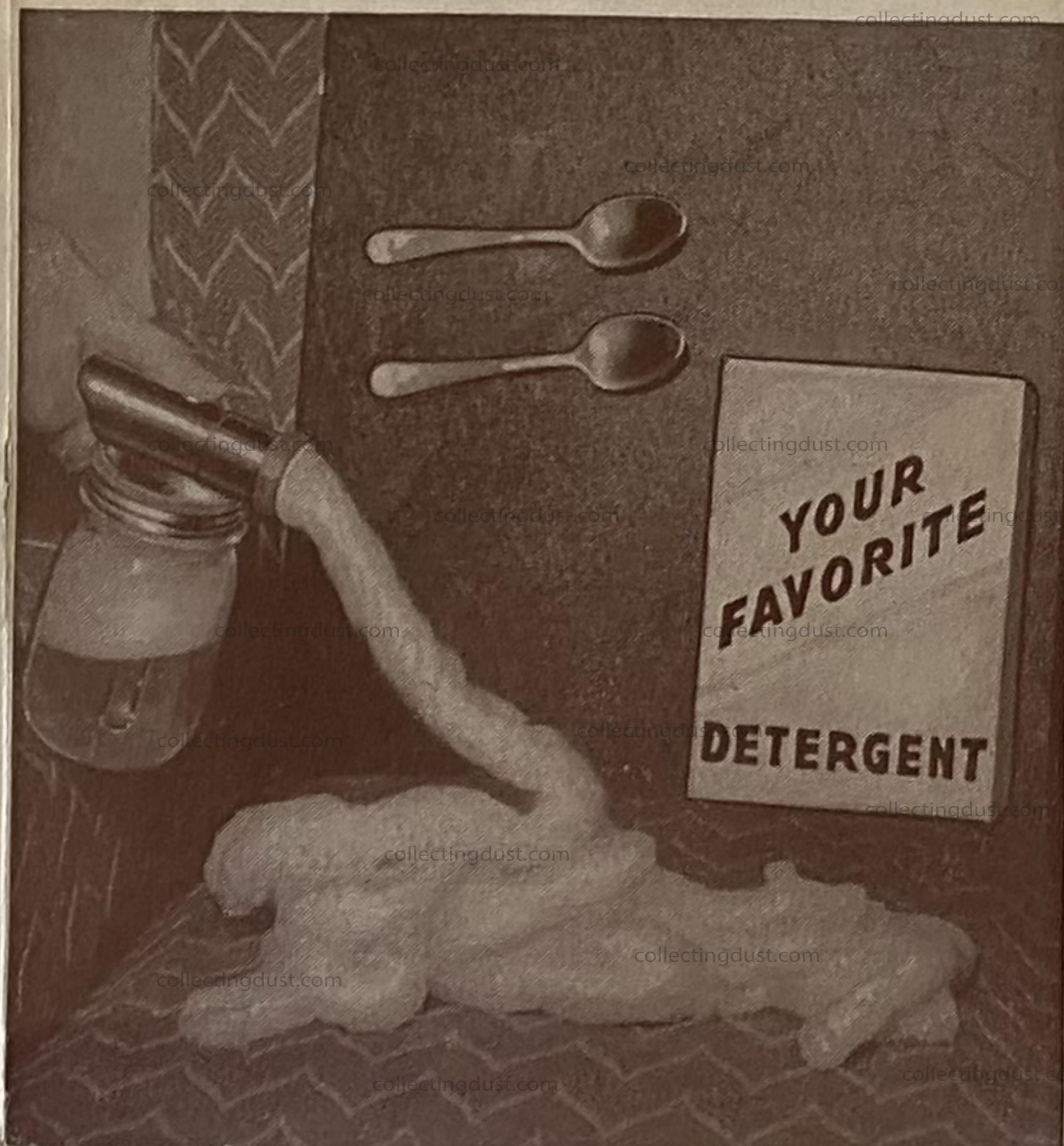
