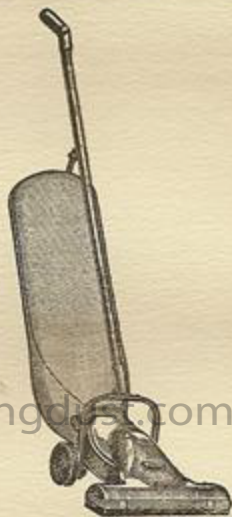

The Vacuette Electric Attachments

Study the accompanying picture Fig. 9 of the very complete set of attachments that are supplied with the Vacuette Electric and learn the names of the various tools and couplings. You will more readily understand the following descriptions of the various ways in which the attachments can be used most effectively.

1. Long hose (8 ft.)
2. Radiator or tufting tool.
3. Hose coupler (8 in.)
4. Extension tube (30 in.)
5. Short hose (3 ft.)
6. Blower hose connection.
7. Upholstery brush.
8. Upholstery nozzle.
9. Small Bag.
10. Suction hose connection.
11. Shoulder strap.
12. Lifter grip.
13. Floor brush.

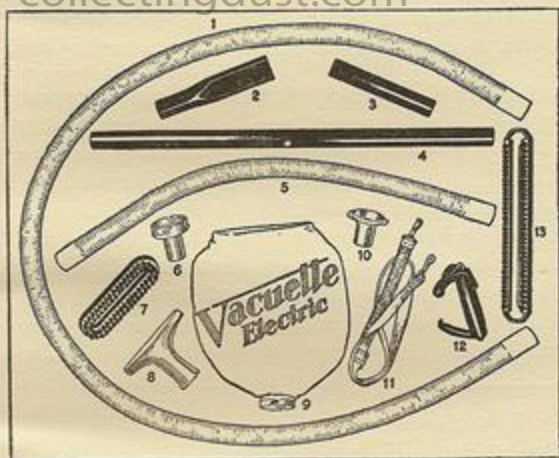

Cleaning Stairways, Mattresses, Etc.

One of the chief advantages of the Vacuette Electric is the very convenient method with which the cleaning of stairways can be accomplished. See Fig. 10.

The long floor handle and large bag are taken off the machine and the lifter grip and small bag substituted.

The rear support of the lifter grip is first fitted into the hole in the motor housing just above
