

The Kirby Heritage features two vacuum cleaner bag systems: the standard disposable filter bag system, and the optional reuseable bag system.


Disposable Filter Bag System. (Standard)

How to change bags.



Before you begin, unplug the cleaner's electrical cord from wall outlet.

collectingdus Unzip the cloth bag at rear of cleaner.







To replace, slide new bag into outer cloth bag, making sure the cardboard plate faces front of cleaner.



Hold the top tab on the cardboard plate while hooking the bottom of the opening under the lower lip of the bag retainer. Once the bottom is secure, pull the top tab up and over the upper lip of retainer.

Your bag should now be snapped into place—check to make sure the cardboard plate is fully on the bag retainer.

Zip the cloth bag closed.

NOTE: When changing the disposable filter bag, empty the Sani Em-Tor of any large particles which may have settled there.

For best results: Never reuse filter bags — this could damage the cleaner. Periodically check to make sure the air passage openings to the filter bag are not blocked. For peak efficiency and performance, use genuine Kirby replacement parts.

Reuseable Bag System. (Optional)

The Sani Em-Tor and Sani-Pocket are patented Kirby features that enable easy and efficient emptying of the reuseable cloth filter bag.

Emptying the Filter Bag.

- Spread newspaper on the floor and place Kirby on it.
- Detach wire loop on top end of the bag from handle bracket. Tilt handle back slightly. Push bag top toward handle and lift loop out of bracket.

Swing cover out from under Sani Em-Tor and turn cover upside down, emptying the dirt and lint onto the paper.

After all dirt has been removed, swing cover back into place and lock securely with locking lever. Make sure that cover gasket is free of dirt and that lever handle is fully rotated.

If excessive dirt and lint has accumulated in the bag, and does not fall readily into the Sani Em-Tor, use the following procedure.



Open zipper at rear of bag and place hand inside Sani-Pocket, grasping Sani-Scraper at bottom.

Scrape sides of bag with Sani-Scraper in downward strokes.

Using Sani-Scraper, push excess lint and dirt into Sani Em-Tor.

Empty as in "5" through "7" above.

3 Lower rug nozzle to No. 1 position (as shown) and turn on motor.

Allow motor to run briefly and then turn off. While bag is still extended, shake it vigorously from the top.

CAUTION! Unplug the cord.



5 Tilt Kirby slightly and rotate side lever fully to release bottom cover of Sani Em-Tor. In the "open" position the lever will point to the rear of the Kirby.



Carpet Vacuuming.

Upright Cleaning.

It's important to have the rug nozzle height set properly to get the most efficient cleaning action. Start out with the Toe-Touch control (30) adjusted to the full up (number 8) position. Then, by pressing your toe downward on the upper part of the Toe-Touch Control, lower the nozzle one step at a time until you notice a change in the sound of the power plant. This indicates that the nozzle is in contact with the rug and ready to clean. Any Ollecting cust.com position lower than this will restrict proper air flow and reduce belt life.

Sweeping Pattern

For the best and easiest cleaning action, push the machine straight away from you and pull it straight back. Change the direction of the machine at the end of the pull back and point it in the direction of the next sweeping path. Continue to do this across the entire rug with slow, gliding motions. Do not jerk or tug the cleaner rapidly on back stroke or when changing directions.



Handle Positions.

When the handle stop latch (28) is pushed to the left a pin extends. This pin will stop the handle from being lowered back to the horizontal. It will lock the handle in the horizontal position for storage, if it is extended with the handle down.

When the pin is out and the handle is upright, pulling back on the handle will cause the front of the machine to tilt up so that it can be moved over obstacles, such as carpet strips or throw rugs.

Cord Release. collecting

To release cord, turn down the upper cord hook on the handle. Cord will drop free into your hand.



Converting to a straight suction cleaner.

Raise the headlight hood and turn the Belt Lifter (16) fully counterclockwise. Check the instruction label on top of the rug nozzle to be sure that the belt is disengaged.

2 Lower the headlight hood against the Belt Lifter. With the belt disengaged the brush roll will not turn and the Kirby becomes a straight suction cleaner.

Converting to a Mattress Cleaner.

WARNING:

Before changing units or attachments, unplug power cord from wall outlet, and be sure motor and fan have stopped.

Unhook clip on top (27) of handle. Pull power cord from the bracket on the back of the handle grip. Release it from the handle fork rear cover clips

WARNING:

Failure to disengage brush roll can be hazardous. Keep hair, clothes, buttons, face and fingers away from the nozzle.

Raise the headlight hood (19) and turn the Belt Lifter fully counterclockwise. With the belt disengaged the brush roll will not turn and the Kirby becomes a straight suction mattress cleaner.



Pull handle pin (12) all the way out and lift handle off the cleaner.



Slide portable handle into the handle channel on the power plant. Push handle pin back in to fasten the portable handle to the power plant. Be sure pin goes through the holes on both sides of the portable handle.



Slide Handle Stop Latch (28) fully in direction of arrow to lock portable handle in place.

Attaching the hose.

To use the above-the-floor tools, the flexible hose must be attached to the front of the Kirby.

st.comWARNING:

Before changing units or attachments, unplug power cord from wall outlet, and be sure motor and fan have stopped.

Move the Toe-Touch Control (30) to the Number 8 position. Then raise headlight hood.



Turn the Belt Lifter (16) counterclockwise, or all the way to the left until it stops. (See instruction label at top of nozzle.)




Unlock the accessory lock (17) that's located under the hood by moving it all the way to the left. Rug nozzle should drop forward slightly.




Remove rug nozzle (15) by lifting it up slightly and pulling it toward you.

Now you are ready to install

the hose.




5 Hook the attaching lugs of the large coupling on the flexible hose over the ends of the attaching bar (14) on the power plant and swing the hose coupling end up against the power plant.



To attach tools, push lightly while twisting the connection of the smaller end of the hose into the desired tool.

Extension tubes and swivel elbow are assembled in the same manner. To avoid breakage, do not jam or force the coupling ends into the attachments.





Rotate the accessory locking lever (17) until hose connector is tightly closed and sealed against power plant. Close the headlight hood.

The Kirby is now ready for above-the-floor cleaning and is ready to accept any of the hose attachments that come with your Kirby.

ATTACHMENTS.

The Crevice Tool.

For deep cleaning in crevices, cracks, corners, grooves, narrow openings, and behind seat cushions of upholstered furniture, attach the crevice tool without the removable brush to the flexible hose or to the extension tubes.

With the removable brush placed in the end of the crevice tool, you have a cleaning tool that removes dirt from corners, between radiator coils, venetian blinds, and sliding window tracks.



Utility Brush Nozzle.

Attach to end of extension tubes and use for cleaning walls, ceilings and large flat surfaces,



The Duster Brush.

Attach the duster brush to the end of the flexible hose or to the extension tubes and you can remove dust from any surface, including those with contours, such as moldings or delicate lamp shades and unusual shapes.




Portable Shoulder Strap.

The shoulder portable is ideal for cleaning in areas where considerable mobility and freedom of hands is required.

Remove the carrying strap from the attachment case and clip the spring clip on each end into the holes at front and back of the portable handle.

Slide the adjusting buckle on the carrying strap so the portable cleaner rests comfortably on your shoulder.



Storing the Flexible Hose.

Never store the flexible hose near a heat source. Keep it in a cool, dry place and never hang it on a sharp hook or nail. Store it in a place where it will be readily available.

TURBO BRUSH.


Turbo Brush.

Ideal for deep cleaning of carpeting and stair treads, as shown.

For maximum cleaning efficiency, keep base plate of Turbo Brush level with the surface being cleaned. The rotating brush may cause particles to be thrown from rear of base plate, if not held level. To reduce suction when vacuuming draperies, clothing, etc., open slide valve (32). Do not insert fingers in open slide valve.




Keep hair, clothes, face and fingers away from rotating brush. Disconnect unit from Kirby before servicing.



Turbo Brush.

This unique portable cleaner makes difficult hand vacuuming jobs easy. Turbo Brush uses a mechanical brushing action to do a thorough cleaning job on carpeted stairs, upholstery, drapes—anywhere an upright cleaner can't be used.


CAUTION: When using the Turbo Brush, keep it moving across the surface to be cleaned. Do not let it remain in one place.



Extension Wands.

Attaching the curved extension tube to the hose, the straight extension tube to the curved tube, the swivel tube to the straight tube, and the surface nozzle to the swivel gives you maximum reach.

Attaching the hose to the straight tube and adding the curved extension tube on the straight extension tube and utility brush nozzle makes an effective wall, ceiling, and baseboard cleaning arrangement.



Surface Nozzle with Swivel Attachment.

The surface nozzle with brush extended is for use on carpeted floor areas. It has a lever on the front of its housing which allows you to raise or lower the brush. The up position of the brush is recommended for the cleaning of deep pile or loose throw rugs.



SERVICE TIPS.

Your Kirby has been designed and manufactured to give you many years of normal in-home usage with relatively little maintenance required.

The Kirby motor has permanently lubricated and sealed ball bearings and will not need lubrication. If bearings become noisy, repair of the motor must be done only by authorized qualified Kirby service personnel.

To maintain your Kirby in good, serviceable condition, it should be inspected periodically by an authorized Kirby service person.



Headlight bulb replacement.

Raise the headlight hood on the power plant. With a Phillips head screwdriver, lossen the two screws that hold the headlight lens to the hood.



2 Unplug the lens and socket assembly from the terminal block. Replace the bulb, plug in the lens and socket assembly, and replace the screws.


NOTICE. All service and maintenance required other than those things described in this book should be done by authorized qualified Kirby service personnel using genuine Kirby replacement parts.

WARNING.

Before servicing, always unplug power cord from wall outlet and be sure the motor and fan have come to a complete stop.

WARNING

Remove Turbo Brush from unit before servicing. Beware of sharp objects that may become lodged in brush.




Brush cleaning of Rug Nozzle.

Keep the brushes and belt track clear of lint, string, hair, and other fibers. Pay particular attention to keeping these fibers away from the bearings at the ends of the brush roll.



Brush adjustment of Rug Nozzle.

After the rug nozzle has been in use for some time, the brush bristles may begin to wear. To adjust the brush height, place the rug nozzle on a table. Place a straight edge on the nozzle plate next to brush tufts to see



protrusion. Turn both screws clockwise an equal amount until the brushes protrude about 1/16 inch past the rug plate. One full turn of these screws moves the brush out about 1/32 inch. Make certain brush roll is kept parallel with rug plate or belt will not center between tufts.




Brush cleaning of Turbo Brush.

Remove base plate by sliding bottom latch back. Clean turbine and/or brush, then replace base plate by inserting tabs into slots on front of unit attaching at bottom latch.



Brush adjustment of Turbo Brush.

To adjust brush to compensate for bristle wear, remove base plate by sliding bottom latch back. Next, remove the belt cover (33) by removing the screw. Finally remove the belt from the pulley. (An aid to belt removal is to turn brush backwards slightly.) Pull the brush assembly out. Turn brush assembly over and re-insert




so that number "1" is showing at both ends.

NOTE: The brush roll comes from the factory with a "2" showing at both ends of the brush roll assembly.


When adjusting brush, make sure no brush bristles are caught between belt and brush roll gear.

CAUTION: Do not operate with belt cover (33) removed.

Belt replacement for Rug Nozzle.



To replace the belt in the rug nozzle, remove the nozzle from the motor and place the nozzle on a table.



Turn the Belt Lifter all the way clockwise until the belt drops off the finger inside the nozzle.


Turn nozzle upside down. Unlock rug plate by means of two latches on rear of nozzle.



3 Pull up on rear of rug plate to pull brush roll and plate out of nozzle.



Bend slightly one end bracket of the rug plate away from one end of brush.



5 Slide the belt off the roll and slide on a new belt. The new belt must be in the middle of the roll. Place the roll back into the end bracket with the screw heads facing the openings in rug plate.



Hook rug plate on front of nozzle and rotate it back against nozzle opening and make certain it fully closes against nozzle. Rotate latches to lock plate in place, and center belt under rug plate center rib. Turn the Belt Lifter counter-clockwise until the finger in the nozzle picks up the

Belt replacement for Turbo Brush.

WARNING Remove Turbo Brush from unit before servicing.

Remove base plate by sliding bottom latch back and belt cover (33) by removing screw. Next, remove belt from pulley (may help to turn brush backwards slightly). Pull belt and brush assembly out and replace belt. Before replacing base plate and belt cover, make sure a "2" is showing at both ends

Troubleshooting.

Many service calls are unnecessary. Checking a few simple things can save a lot of cost, time and trouble. Whenever your Kirby does not perform properly, make these checks first before calling authorized service personnel.

If the motor does not start when the motor ON-OFF switch is pushed:

- 1. Make sure the power cord is plugged into an outlet and that the outlet has power. (Check for tripped circuit breaker or power company trouble.)
- 2. Make sure the cord plug is fully inserted into the cleaner.
- 3. Look for breaks in the power cord insulation. If the cord is damaged, get a new one. DO NOT ATTEMPT TO REPAIR IT
- Make sure that an attachment or accessory is properly mounted on the front of the power plant.

If the Kirby does not pick up lint or litter on the carpet:

- Make sure that the belt is on the brush roll and on the power plant drive pulley.
- 2. Make sure that the belt is not broken or slipping. Replace if



Check suction seal ring gasket on front of cleaner to see that it's not missing or damaged. Do not use cleaner without a gasket.

- Check to see that suction seal ring gasket is not missing in the hose connector. Do not use if missing or damaged.
- Check to see if rug plate on carpet nozzle is properly attached and latched.
- Make sure that the Toe-Touch control is adjusted to place the nozzle in contact with the rug.
- Make sure the brush roll is adjusted properly and the bristles are not worn out. 1/16 inch of tuft should extend out of nozzle plate. Check with ruler against nozzle. Replace or adjust as required.
- 8. Make sure bag is not full.
- Check to be certain that fill tube and Sani Em-Tor are not clogged.



If the Sani Em-Tor is loose:

- Make sure it locked in position.
- Make sure the rubber gasket inside the collar of the Sani Em-Tor is properly in place; dirt will blow out if it is not. Replace if the Sani Em-Tor gasket is missing or damaged.

If the brush roll in any accessory does not turn:

- Make sure the belt is not broken or worn out.
- Make sure the belt is in place around the brush roll and on the power plant pulley.
- Check to see if brush roll can be rotated.

If the Kirby is hard to push when the rug nozzle is attached:

- Make sure the nozzle is not set too low. Raise the Toe-Touch control one or two notches.
- Make sure that the belt is on the brush roll and on the power plant drive pulley.
- Make sure that the belt is not broken or slipping. Replace if necessary.

All transportation expenses must be borne by the purchaser. 


